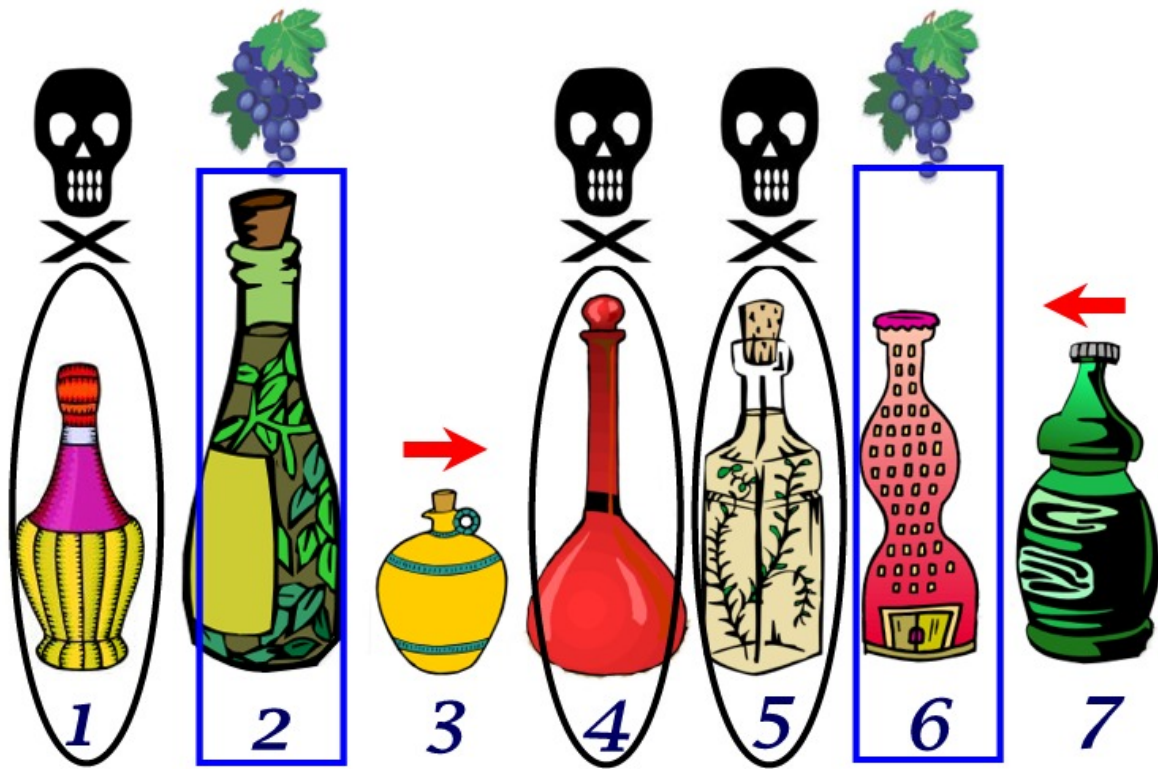


Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone



Bottles 1, 4, and 5 contain poison.
 Bottles 2 and 6 contain Nettle wine.
 Bottle 3 moves you forward toward the Stone.
 Bottle 7 moves you back from where you came.

Reasoning:

1. The third clue tells you that neither the largest (2) nor smallest (3) bottles contain poison.
2. The fourth clue tells you that the second bottle from the right (6) is not poison (since it is the same as bottle 2).
3. The first clue tells you that the poison is to the left of the Nettle wine, so bottles 1 and 5 are poison.
4. At this point, bottles 4 or 7 could also contain poison. The second clue tells that bottles at each end are different, so bottle 7 cannot be poison, since bottle 1 is poison. Bottle 4 must be poison.
5. Now, you know that bottles 3 and 7 are the magic bottles of escape.
6. The second clue tells you that the end bottles will not move you forward, so bottle 7 moves you back and bottle 3 moves you forward.
